Did you know:

- If a student becomes unwell at school, they should report to their class teacher who will provide a note for access to Sick Bay. If needed, students will be monitored for 15 minutes and then return to class or be sent home. Where parents are unable to arrange collection, the school may call an ambulance if deemed necessary.
Students are not to remain in sick bay for extended periods of time, and parents/carers are encouraged to keep students home until they are well, and ensure that students are provided with adequate food and a water bottle (especially during hot weather), as well as suitable uniforms whilst at school. The Queensland Health Time Out Poster can provide information on recommended exclusion times for infectious conditions.
