Did you Know:

• Permission notes for the Junior Rewards trips have bee issued. They are due in QParents by 1 December, and payment is due 3 December. Due to tight end of year timelines, late responses may not be accepted.

<u>Centrepay</u> is a free and voluntary service offered by the Commonwealth Government to Centrelink payment recipients. Eligible parents can use Centrepay to pay bills and expenses, like education fees, as regular deductions from their Centrelink payments. There is a \$10.00 per fortnight minimum amount for each deduction.

Centrepay account credit balances: New rules apply for accounts in credit. If you have Centrepay credits that are over six months old, they need to be used or refunded.

Parents are urged to check their student account balances and make arrangements for any extended credit to be used (eg back to school uniform purchases from the Canteen). If you have any questions, please contact the Office.
