To this end students will be able to visit static displays and attend lectures from a wide variety of organisations. It is hoped that through attendance at this day students will be able to make informed decisions about their future careers and their subject selections for 2018.

Participating organizations will include individual local employers, Industry representatives, Group Training representatives, TAFE, Tertiary Institutions, Social Service Agencies, Australian Defence Force and Police.

This is a compulsory event for all Year 10 students. It is provided at no cost to families. Students will be expected to present in full formal school uniform. Students will need to bring lunch and/or afternoon tea - the canteen will be operating as per normal.

As there are no classes occurring on the day, students are not required to bring workbooks with them. However, they will require a blue/black pen for the day to record information and to take notes at their small group presentations.

Parents/carers are also invited to attend a subject selection information session to be held later in the evening. This will commence at 6.00pm in the Assembly Hall (opposite the library) and will provide parents/carers an opportunity to hear important information about studies in Years 11 and 12 as well as having an opportunity to speak with staff about subjects being offered for Year 11.
