Re: STAR Sessions at Toowoomba SHS in 2024

Dear Parent/ Caregiver,

In 2023 we implemented an enrichment and enhancement program we called STAR sessions –Student Tuition and Remote Learning.

STAR sessions occur every Wednesday afternoon from 1:45pm, used as a time when Junior students can access a variety of online literacy and numeracy resources that have been set by their teachers. Senior students have also been using the time, however, with greater flexibility in line with their academic program, allowing them dedicated individual study time, the opportunity to access their school-based apprenticeship or traineeship (SBT), TAFE courses or work experience.

This program has been a great success and, as such, the school will continue the program in 2024 for Years 8-12 students. Students in Years 8-12 who have returned completed permissions forms are allowed to leave the school and undertake their STAR session activities from home. At this stage, all Year 7 students must remain at school and will not be participating in STAR sessions.

In 2024, we require a new completed permission form for ALL Year 8-12. This is required as circumstances for each student and family can change from year to year.

Students with permission forms will be required to leave the grounds, go straight home and will be considered to be under the supervision of their parents/carers.
